



Notice of Acceptance

Merger of Croydon PCT's provider services arm and Mayday Healthcare NHS Trust

The Cooperation and Competition Panel (CCP) has decided that the proposed transfer of the provider services arm of Croydon PCT (Croydon Community Health Services) to Mayday Healthcare NHS trust meets the CCP's acceptance criteria for a merger reference. That is:

- i. the proposed arrangement falls within the scope of Principles 9 and 10 of the Principles and Rules for Cooperation and Competition;
- ii. the CCP is the most appropriate body to consider this matter;
- iii. the parties have made available the relevant and applicable information on the case to the CCP; and
- iv. the turnover threshold is satisfied as the combined entities will exceed the relevant threshold for mergers involving a community services provider of £35 million.

As a result, the CCP is accepting this case with its investigation starting from the date of this notice, with Phase 1 to be completed by 20 April 2010 and Phase 2, if required, to be completed by 12 August 2010.¹
